2. **LECTIONARY FOR MASS SUPPLEMENT - COMING APRIL 1, 2017.** The new Lectionary for Mass Supplement will be available beginning April 1, 2017 and may be used immediately upon purchase. Three publishers have produced ritual editions:

In 2015, the USCCB's Secretariat for Divine Worship began to compile all the updated additions and corrections to the Lectionary since the first edition of the Lectionary for Mass was released in 1969. At its meeting in June 2015, the Committee for Divine Worship formally approved the publication of a supplement.
